Eucharistic Revival Ignites 100 Year Old Memories

For the Catholics of Steuben County, the arrival of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage in Angola this Sunday is reminiscent of 100 years ago, nearly to the day, in 1924 when the first Mass in Angola was celebrated and Christ in the Eucharist came to Angola for the very first time.

In the late 1920's, Steuben County remained the least Catholic County of Indiana when Bishop John F. Noll mandated St Michael Parish in Waterloo develop a mission church in "the wild lake country around Angola." Previous efforts of missionaries to develop the territory were thwarted by bootleggers and fur trappers.



Undaunted, three priests from St. Michael led by Fr. Orth answered the call and celebrated Mass at irregular intervals at different locations in town. The first Mass was celebrated in the Angola High School gym in July of 1924. Mass continued there until September when summer vacationers declined. The few remaining parishioners rented rooms above Elton's Shoe Store on West Maumee Street in order that Masses could continue. To handle burgeoning summer populations our former church was built in 1956 as a temporary church. It took until 2010 to finally retire the old church and build our present church.

While Mass was held in four different churches over the past one hundred years, with attendance often meager in the winter and ballooning to thousands in the summer, the primary tenet of the faith, Christ fully present in the Eucharist, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity remained.

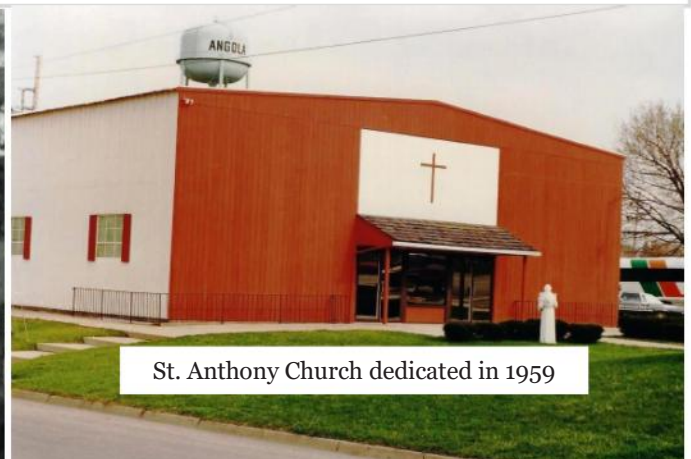
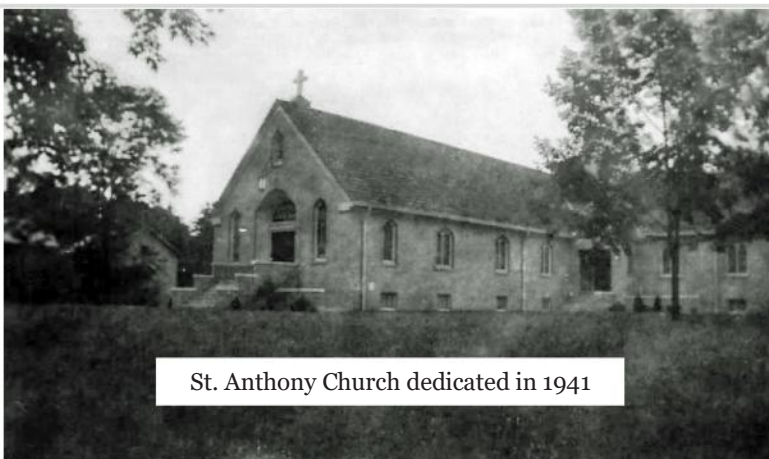
This weekend St. Anthony Parish has the honor of welcoming Christ to our city once again as pilgrims on the Marian Route of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage winding their way from the headwaters of the Mississippi in Minnesota to Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress.

Everyone is invited to dinner at Trine University at 6 pm where we will break bread with the pilgrims who are literally walking the road with Jesus and hear their stories. Following dinner guests are invited to St. Anthony where Fr. David Langford will share his Emmaus moments prior to adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Fully expecting guests will be reluctant to leave the glow of the inspirational evening, there will be a social hour in the gathering space to end the evening.

The celebration continues Monday morning at 8 am Mass followed by a procession to the circle prior to the pilgrimage continuing on its journey .

Next stop?.....Where the journey began, St. Anthony's founding parish, St. Michael in Waterloo!
