

#### A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

Third Sunday of Lent

Unfortunately, we live in a world full of noise - noise not only for our ears but also visual noise, with so many screens Unfortunately, we live in a world full of noise – noise not only for our ears but also visual noise, with so many screens everywhere: in restaurants, on the streets, at home, and in our hands. This external noise causes our souls to also be noisy as well, crowded with thoughts that are often trivial. This excessive sentimentality clouds our soul and our reason, disrupting our inner stillness. Let us reflect on the wisdom of Saint Mother Teresa, who teaches us about the importance of silence – "We need to find God and God cannot be found in noise and restlessness. God is the friend of silence. See how nature – trees, flowers, grass – grow in silence; see the stars, the moon, the sun, how they move in silence. Is not our mission to give God to the poor in the slums? Not a dead God, but a living, loving God. The more we receive in silent prayer, the more we can give in our active life. We need silence to be able to touch souls. The essential thing is not what we say, but what God says to us and through us. All our words will be useless unless they come from within – words that do not give the light of Christ increase the darkness." Lent is a time for silence, allowing God to break our deafness and for us to hear His voice that speaks in the depths of our souls and recollects in silence to seek His face.

#### The Scrutinies

A scrutiny is one of the minor rites of the RCIA that involves self-searching and repentance. The purpose of the scrutinies is to strengthen the person to overcome temptations and to be strong in choosing what is upright and in following the Gospel. There are three scrutinies. After the readings and homily at Mass, the presider invites the catechumens and the assembly to silent prayer, intercessions for the Elect follows. The presider pronounces the exorcism. The exorcism is addressed to Christ, asking him to drive out the power of evil and replace it with the Holy Spirit. Scrutinies are celebrated on the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent. Please continue to pray for all of our Catechumens and Candidate.

What is the significance of the color purple during Lent?

The color purple is an additional symbol of penance. The Scriptures tell us that a purple garment was placed on Jesus during his passion as a mockery. It is fitting that the color be maintained during the days in which we focus on our own reality of sin that continues to be a mockery of the love and goodness of God. The color purple and the days of penance themselves will eventually give way to the color white and celebration of Christ's victory over sin. In humility we acknowledge our sin in penance so that we may share fully in the celebration to come. All the crosses, statues, & paintings will be covered with purple fabric on April 4 until the end of the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but statues & images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.


