A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Most people believe that the problems, crosses, or concerns of our lives are curses from evil or "karma,"... but today, Jesus says the contrary in today's Gospel: they are blessings, and we are indeed blessed when we are poor, hungry, suffering, despised, excluded ...

What? Are you serious? Are you sick? What do you mean? Those could be the typical questions of one who doesn't know what true Christianism is, but I have even heard those questions from Catholics....

Our journey is about only one thing: LOVE. That's it. Is a good mother able to give her life for her children? Yes. Is a good mother able to not eat to give food to her children? Yes. Is a good mother able to say she is ok when she is in pain? Yes. Is a good mother able to weep in silence so that no one notices it? Yes. You see, sacrifice is the same as love. Only those who love Jesus with all their hearts will be able to find sweetness in bitterness because they know it is a wonderful opportunity to accompany Jesus on His cross - what an honor it is to be with Him there, consoling and being supportive of him. "Lord Jesus, if this sadness and dryness in my soul make you happy, I will accept them with joy so that you will be happy. I love you" - St. Teresa of Calcutta. Try to discover Jesus' face in your sorrows. God loves you with great tenderness, Happy Sunday!

AUDIO SYSTEM AT ST. ANTHONY UPDATE

Unfortunately, since we have built our Church in 2010, we have had 2 audio system updates to help better the sound quality. After recently having a pre-commissioning done of the current system and a sound engineer diagnosis done, we feel confident this will be the last update needed, unless it's to update outdated equipment. We will add 2 more hanging speakers on the south side near the choir loft and last section, plus update the current outdated subwoofer, processor, receivers and mixer. We will also install the highly requested Hearing Aid Assistance that has Wi-Fi capability.

The Finance Council has approved \$10,000 & Altar & Rosary has donated \$10,000 for the project. We would like to ask for donations to help fund the remaining balance. Please see Katie Waltke in the Parish Office for more information. Project Leader: John Peters

What is a jubilee year?

A Jubilee Year in the Catholic Church is a special year of grace and celebration, marked by prayers, pilgrimages, and reconciliation. During this time, you are invited to deepen your faith through acts of charity, restitution, and a renewed commitment to the Gospel. Traditionally, the Church celebrates a Jubilee Year every 25 years, but it can be proclaimed more or less frequently (such as the Jubilee Year of Mercy in 2016.) Each Jubilee Year emphasizes a different focus. The Jubilee Year of Hope invites you to focus on the hope that the Gospel brings to the world, particularly in times of crisis and uncertainty.

Jubilee Years begin with the opening of the Holy Doors, a symbol of Christ's open invitation to all. This is done at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome and in dioceses across the globe, inviting pilgrims to walk through it as a sign of their journey toward spiritual renewal. The Holy Doors were opened in the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend on December 29, 2024 at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception.


